

TCT SCHOLARSHIP

For high school seniors and
continuing education students



OBJECTIVE

TCT invites graduating high school seniors and continuing education students to apply for one of ten scholarships being offered for the academic year 2017-2018. Five \$500 scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors and five \$500 scholarships will be awarded to continuing education students. These scholarships will be awarded to successful applicants who will be enrolling in ANY postsecondary institution (accredited community college, technical school, four-year college or university) having at least a one-year degree program through the bachelor degree level. Scholarships will be awarded to selected students upon official proof of enrollment.

SELECTION

To qualify, applicant must be a graduate of a high school served by TCT* and a dependent of a TCT customer. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need, and student's accomplishments and community service record.

* Exceptions: (1) High school seniors who, because of school district boundaries, must attend high schools not served by TCT. (2) Continuing students who did not graduate from a local high school but whose permanent residence is within the boundaries of TCT.

ELIGIBILITY:

Students must be enrolled full-time, carrying at least 12 credit hours. Preference will be given to students whose vocational goals can be linked with engineering, computer technology, telecommunications, electronics, or associated fields.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. The following application must be typed or printed, completed in full and signed by both applicant and parent or guardian. Incomplete applications WILL NOT be considered.
2. Seniors must submit high school transcript through the 7th semester showing ACT and/or SAT scores.
3. Continuing education students must submit the current official transcript from the school most recently attended. Applications will not be accepted from continuing education students until after a term has been completed and grades recorded on the official transcript.
4. Two letters of reference must be included with application; one from a teacher or counselor and one from someone not associated with your high school or post-secondary school.
